Standard of Conduct for NOAH Elementary School Athletes

I will participate with all diligence, giving my best efforts at all times (from the time I make the team roster to the end of the season, including end of the season activities) by:

1. Attending the required participants' meetings, clinics, practices, and competitions and arriving on time, or letting the appropriate coach know well in advance why I will not be attending.
2. Refraining from harsh criticism of my teammates, opponents, coaches, officials and tournament officials and speaking with respect to all adults
3. Maintaining the required academic standards set by my parents.
4. Appealing concerns or problems through my team captains and/or my coaches, then, if necessary, the athletic director, or finally the NOAH board through the president.
5. Playing fairly and following the rules of my sport during practices and competitions.
6. Respecting facilities and equipment at home, while traveling, or at a host site; I will try to leave it in as good or better shape than I found it (picking up trash, treating the facilities with respect, etc.)

Recognizing that I am a representative of NOAH and at ALL NOAH activities or activities that I will be representing NOAH, I will abide by the following standards:

1. I will dress myself modestly and honor the following dress code (The intent of this code is to encourage an appearance of team unity and to discourage individual attention getting)
No tank tops, spaghetti straps, crop tops or muscle shirts will be worn (with the exception of uniforms during games)
No short, skirts or dresses shorter than 6 inches from the top of the knee when standing
No sheer, clinging or tight fitting clothing
No inappropriate words or graphics on clothing
No extreme hairstyles
2. NOAH does not approve of tattoos, therefore no exposed tattoos are allowed by participants. Lev. 19:28
3. Out of respect for myself and others, I will refrain from inappropriate public displays of affection toward individuals who are not members of my immediate family; this includes kissing, holding hands, etc.
4. Refraining from cursing and coarse or foul language.

I understand that it would be impossible to make a comprehensive list of inappropriate dress and/or inappropriate activities; therefore, in the event a judgment needs to be made I will respect the determination of board directors, team coordinators, and/or coaches.
